Make your voice heard outside of the classroom or administrative office. TEA needs your experience to review potential questions, define test performance levels, and determine scoring boundaries.

Teachers, instructional coaches, content specialists and administrators play an essential role in the assessment development process through:

- **Passage Review**
 - ✓ Reviewing each potential Reading Language Arts (RLA) test passage.
- **Item Review**
 - ✓ Reviewing and approving each potential question for a state test.
- **Constructed Response Range-Finding**
 - ✓ Setting the scoring boundaries for student essays.
- **Subject-Area Advisory Group**
 - ✓ Providing feedback on subject-area-specific topics.
- **Standard-Setting**
 - ✓ Establishing cut scores that define performance levels.
